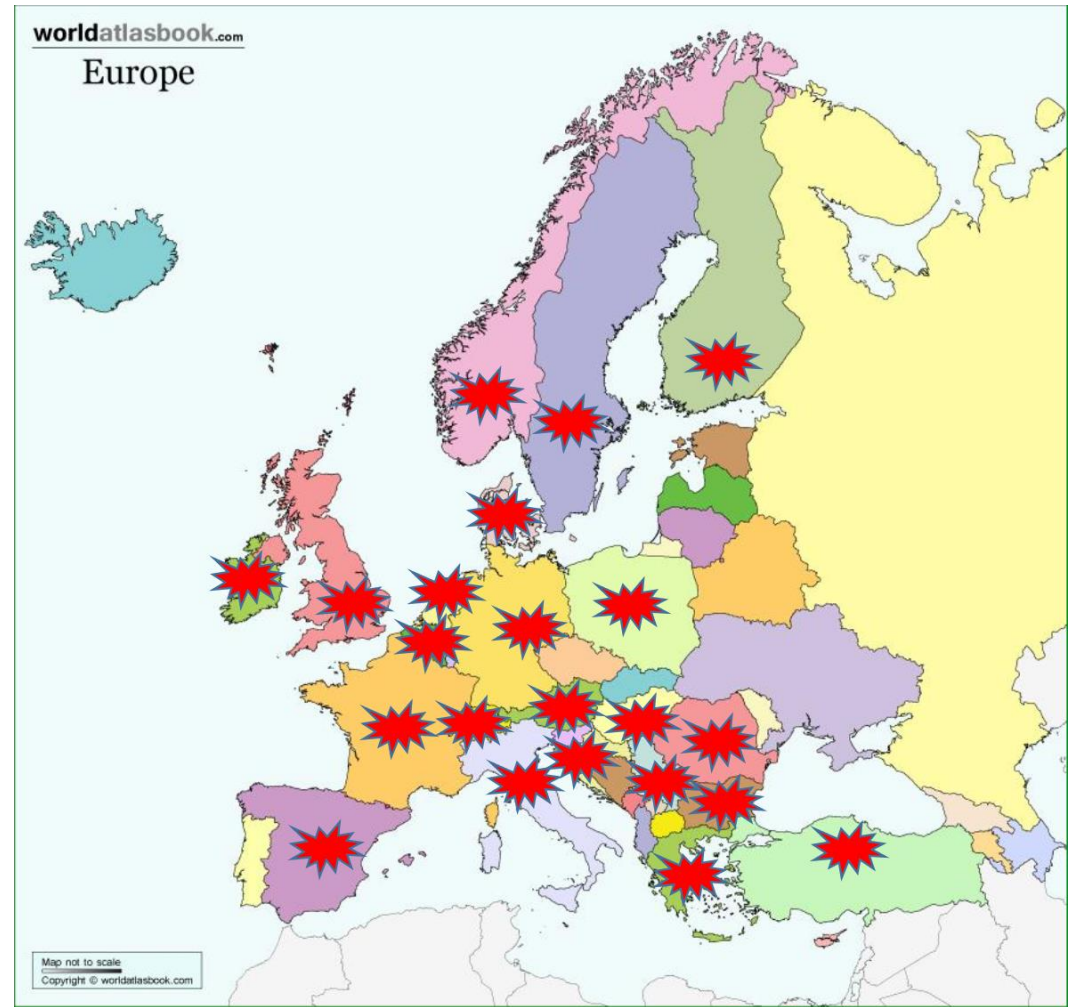

- **PLAN-E was founded October 2014 in Amsterdam**
- **PLAN-E is a social network of escience organisations across Europe, with the following characteristics**
 - They operate closely to or with the researchers
 - They operate closely with the ICT, ICT-infrastructure and Computer Science domains
 - They develop, evaluate, create new solutions to problems and cover HPC, Data Scienc, Visualisation, Cloud and cross-resource integration and other relevant ICT-related domains or technology
- **PLAN-E general aims are**
 - advocate the optimal application of digital technologies in academic research
 - promote the use of outcomes from computer and data science and the methodologies from computational science

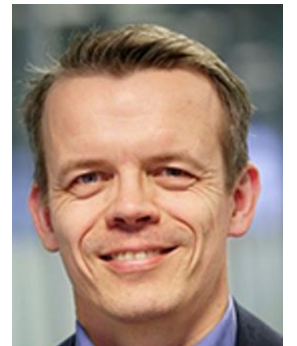
