e-Science in Sweden

e-Science selected as one (of 20) Strategic Research Areas in 2008 Government Bill on Research and Innovation

- In total 1350 MSEK/year additional funding to Swedish Universities
- Earmarked Grants for 2010-2020. Goal: Permanent funding
- 5,6 MEUR/year to e-Science research:
 - SeRC grant 3,0 MEUR/year
 - **eSSENCE grant 2,6 MEUR/year**

Lund University

- Founded in 1666 – one of the “two old comprehensive universities in Sweden”
- 40,000 students (Lund municipality has 121 500 inhabitants)
- The PLAN-E meeting will be at the Pufendorf Institute of Advanced Science.
